**Mission:** SAVMA is a professional association promoting excellence in the field of volunteer program management, providing educational programs, leadership, state-of-the-art information and resources, networking opportunities and support to the volunteer community throughout Southern Arizona.

## Membership Categories

This information is excerpted from the organizational by-laws. Annual membership fees are assessed by the Board of Directors.

### **Organizational Membership - \$75 (up to three voting members)**

Organizational memberships are available to incorporated entities for multiple memberships from the same organization. Organizational membership holders shall designate at least one (1) and no more than three (3) members to represent the organization in the association. Memberships are transferable within the organization.

The organization board of directors must endorse the use of the SAVMA Member Code of Ethics in their organization.

### **Individual Membership- \$45**

Open to persons who hold some degree of responsibility directly for volunteer management, and are associated, or have been associated, with an organization that utilizes volunteers. The individual must adhere to the SAVMA Member Code of Ethics.

### **Collegiate (Individual) Membership- \$25**

Membership in this category is open to students in a two- or four-year degree granting, certificate, or diploma program at an accredited college or university.

### **Supporting \$100**

This is a great membership for funders, and corporate memberships are available to independently incorporated entities for multiple memberships from the same organization. A supporting organization is not entitled to vote nor does a Supporting Membership confer any of the rights to benefits of a membership.
